SUMMER INTENSIVE SCHEDULE

June 5 – 9 & June 12 – 16

LEVEL 5

For students who are/were in Ballet Lubbock Level 5 for the 2022 - 2023 season, or new students who have completed four to five years of ballet training.

Schedule: Monday – Friday from 10:00 am to 3:45 pm

Classes: Ballet, Jazz/Hip Hop, Pre-Pointe, Character (Week 1), Dance History (Week 1), Tap (Week 2), Modern (Week 2), etc.

Price: \$325 for one week, \$600 for two weeks

LEVEL 6

For students who are/were in Ballet Lubbock Level 6 for the 2022 - 2023 season, or new students who have completed five to six years of ballet training.

Schedule: Monday – Friday from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm

Classes: Ballet, Pointe, Jazz/Hip Hop, Modern/Contemporary, Character (Week 1), Tap and Musical Theatre (Week 2)

Price: \$325 for one week, \$600 for two weeks

LEVEL 7

For students who are/were in Ballet Lubbock Level 7 for the 2022 - 2023 season, or new students who have completed five to six years of ballet training.

Schedule: Monday – Friday from 9:30 am to 4:15 pm

Classes: Conditioning, Ballet, Pointe/Variation, Contemporary, Hip Hop (Week 1), Character (Week 1), Yoga (Week 2), Musical Theatre (Week 2)

Price: \$325 for one week, \$600 for two weeks

ADVANCED

For students who are/were in Ballet Lubbock Level 8 - Company for the 2022 - 2023 season, or new students who have completed five to six years of ballet training with pointe experience.

Schedule: Monday – Friday from 9:30 am to 4:45 pm

Classes: Conditioning, Ballet, Pointe/Variation, Jazz/Hip Hop, Contemporary, Character (Week 1), Hip Hop (Week 1), Career/College Mentorship (Week 2), Musical Theatre (Week 2)

Price: \$375 for one week, \$700 for two weeks

BOYS' WORKSHOP

Boys' Conditioning Workshop is available as either a stand-alone class or as an addition to Summer Intensive.

*Price listed is for stand-alone classes. If your dancer is already enrolled in Summer Intensive, this class is included in the overall cost and will take the place of other Ballet and Conditioning classes.

DANCE DISCOVERIES SCHEDULE

June 19 – 23 & June 26 - 30

CREATIVE MOVEMENT For students who have completed Creative Movement and/or 3-year-olds by May 1, 2023.

Schedule: Monday – Friday from 8:30 am to 10:00 am

Classes: Ballet, Story Dance

Price: \$100 for one week, \$175 for two weeks

PRE-BALLET For students who have completed Pre-Ballet and/or 4-year-olds by May 1, 2023.

Schedule: Monday – Friday from 8:30 am to 10:15 am

Classes: Ballet, Story Dance

Price: \$125 for one week, \$200 for two weeks

BEGINNING BALLET For students who have completed Beginning Ballet and/or 5-year-olds who have finished kindergarten.

Schedule: Monday – Friday from 8:30 am to 10:30 am

Classes: Ballet, Story Dance

Price: \$150 for one week, \$250 for two weeks

LEVEL 1 For students who have completed Level 1 or have 2 years of ballet.

Schedule: Monday – Friday from 11:00 am to 2:15 pm

Classes: Ballet, Jazz, Character Dance, Story Ballet

Price: \$200 for one week, \$350 for two weeks

JUNIOR INTENSIVE SCHEDULE

June 19 – 23 & June 26 – 30

LEVEL 2

For students who have completed Level 2 or have 3 years of ballet.

Schedule: Monday – Friday from 11:15 am to 2:45 pm

Classes: Ballet, Jazz, Story Ballet

Price: \$200 for one week, \$350 for two weeks

LEVEL 3

For students who have completed Level 3 or have 4 years of ballet.

Schedule: Monday – Friday from 11:30 am to 3:15 pm

Classes: Ballet, Story Ballet, Jazz

Price: \$225 for one week, \$400 for two weeks

LEVEL 4

For students who are/were in Ballet Lubbock Level 4 for the 2022 - 2023 season, or new students who have completed three to four years of ballet training.

Schedule: Monday – Friday from 2:30 to 6:00 pm

Classes: Ballet, Jazz, Modern, Story Ballet

Price: \$275 for one week, \$500 for two weeks

CHOREOGRAPHY WORKSHOP SCHEDULE

CHOREOGRAPHY WORKSHOP

The Contemporary Choreography Workshop is intended for dancers who either took Level 5 – Company classes at Ballet Lubbock during the '22 – '23 school year; or for dancers outside of Ballet Lubbock ages 13 – 18 as of May 1, 2023.

- Schedule:** Monday – Saturday: 9:30 AM – 4:00 PM
Saturday In-Studio Showcase: 2:00 PM – 3:00 PM
- Classes:** Contemporary Ballet / Modern / Partnerwork, Choreographic Composition, Creative Discussion / Lecture
- Price:** \$350

The maximum enrollment for this class is 20 students. Instructors are Ballet Lubbock's Director of Community Engagement Katrina Soricelli and Assistant Artistic Director Lily Balogh.

GUIDELINES

Please note the following guidelines for **ALL** students:

- The Ballet Lubbock Dress Code can be found here: <https://balletlubbock.org/parent-resources/dress-code/>.
- Hair must be secured up and off of the neck, in a bun or protective style. If hair is too short for such a style, please secure up and off the neck with clips, combs, bobby pins, etc.
- All jewelry should be removed prior to class to prevent injury and distraction.
- Please label all dance shoes, clothing, and other items brought to the school with your dancer's name.
- Every dancer should bring a bottle for water each day. Ballet Lubbock has a reverse osmosis water system.
- Dancers in Levels 2 and 3, Summer Intensive, and the Choreography Workshop need to bring their own lunch every day. If you are dropping off food for your dancer, please avoid food from restaurants like Chick-fil-A that fry their food in peanut oil.
- Dancers in Junior Intensive are permitted to bring a snack each day.
- **Due to severe peanut allergies, we do not permit food with peanuts or peanut-based products (such as peanut oil used to fry foods at restaurants like Chick-fil-A) at Ballet Lubbock. Food is never allowed in a dance studio and should only be consumed in designated areas.**

Please register online as soon as possible to ensure that your dancer will have a place in the appropriate class.

If your dancer has never been enrolled at Ballet Lubbock and is older than 5 years old, we will need to conduct a placement lesson to ensure that they are placed in the appropriate class/level based on their physical development and ability. Registration is handled entirely on a first-come, first-served basis.
